McCreary School - Exam Information

Regular classes for semester two end on Friday, June 14th, 2019 for students in grades 9 to 12. High school exams will begin on Monday, June 17th and go until Thursday, June 20th. Please read the following information regarding exam rules.

Exams will be written in the MPR. Exams will begin at 8:55am each morning. Students are required to be in the MPR by no later than 8:50am. Tardiness is not acceptable and students who arrive late will not be given additional time to complete their exam unless there is a legitimate reason (eg. bus arriving late). Students will be given three hours to write the exam and must remain in the MPR until 10:30am, regardless of what time they finish writing the exam. Only materials required for writing the exam will be permitted in the MPR. Students will not be permitted to bring backpacks, purses, jackets, electronic devices, etc. into the MPR. Talking to other students or referring to prohibited notes while the exam is in progress will result in the removal of the exam and a mark of zero for that exam. All exams are to be written the day they are scheduled. An exam deferred to an alternate date must have prior administrative permission and be for legitimate reasons.

When students are finished writing their exam they may leave the school, provided they have consent via the school leaving form. If students do not have a school leaving form parents may pick their child up or contact the school through a note or phone call giving permission for their child to leave the school for the day.

Students who remain at school after their exam will be required to remain in the assigned study room, where supervision will be provided.

All course work for semester one courses must be completed by Friday, June 14th, 2019 by 9:00am (unless prior alternative arrangements have been made specifically with the teacher). Any assignments not turned in by this time will be given a mark of zero.
