SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

1. School Rules

- 1.1 Respect everyone at school
- 1.2 Respect your own property and everyone else's property
- 1.3 Do not interrupt the teaching
- 1.4 Do not interrupt other students' learning
- 1.5 Act safely at all times
- 1.6 No bullying
- 1.7 No swearing
- 1.8 Prepare and exit for recess as well as enter after recess in a quick and quiet manner

2. In-School Code of Conduct

- 2.1 Speak respectfully and in French at all times
- 2.2 Use appropriate indoor tone of voice
- 2.3 Walk quietly in hallways
- 2.4 Eating allowed only in lunchroom and in classroom

3. Student Arrival and Departure

- 3.1 Students must exit and enter the school by their designated door
- 3.2 Students who do not ride the school bus may arrive at school at 8:45 and wait with the school bus students until entrance bell at 8:45.
- 3.3 Students who do not ride the school bus must wait to leave the premises until all school buses have left schoolyard

4. Gum Chewing

- 4.1 It is not permitted to chew gum in the school

5. Head Apparel

- 5.1 Students must remove all head apparel upon entering the school on regular school days (i.e. hats, bandanas)

6. Boots and Outside Footwear

- 6.1 Students must remove outside footwear upon entering the school on the carpeted area provided
- 6.2 Students must place their outside footwear on the shelves provided for them
- 6.3 Students must use separate indoor and outdoor footwear

7. Electronic devices and cell phones

- 7.1 K-5 students: All communication devices possessed by a student may not be used in the school during the regular school day.
6-7-8 students: Grade 6, 7 and 8 students are permitted to have electronic communication devices at recess breaks and lunch hour.

SCHOOL YARD CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Schoolyard Conduct:

Students will:

- 1.1 Listen to supervising teacher at all times
- 1.2 Play safely at all times in designated areas
- 1.3 Report promptly any inappropriate behavior to a supervising teacher
- 1.4 Remain on the school grounds except with the principal's written permission or accompanied by staff or own parent between 8:50a.m. and 3:20 p.m.
- 1.5 Share equipment and yard territory
- 1.6 No eating or drinking in schoolyard

2. Playing Safely in the Schoolyard:

- 2.1 Designated play areas are limited to the schoolyard boundaries. Non-designated areas are the school parking lots, the South side of the school and near entrance doors.
- 2.2 Wrestling, play fighting, harmful physical contact (i.e.. karate, tackle football) are not permitted.
- 2.3 Swings: No jumping off swings
No side to side
No twisting or spinning
Stay clear of moving swings
No under ducks
One person per swing
- 2.4 Slides: Students are to go down the slide feet first one at a time.
No shoving or pushing when going up the stairs
No walking up the slide
No throwing objects on the slide
No playing at the bottom of the slide area
- 2.5 Teeter totters: Only two people on one teeter totter at a time
- 2.6 Trees: No tree climbing
No breaking branches
No playing with broken branches/sticks
- 2.7 Sleds: No standing
No jumping into moving sleds
- 2.8 Play structure: No running or tag
Only students tall enough for the glider are permitted to use it
- 2.9 Mini Hockey: 2 nets per game
2 players per team
Players must be on their knees
Bring your own stick, balls provided
- 2.10 Playhouse: Only students in grades K-3 allowed.
